Cyberspace is the new battlefield where commercial, federal, state, and local government agencies, including the DoD, have become virtual targets. Threats include critical infrastructures such as the energy, transportation, health, emergency services, telecommunications, financial systems, shipping, food, water, and chemical sectors. Organizations require CAP®s to monitor and protect their network infrastructure and information systems. The Federal Government recognizes the CAP® credential in DoD 8140 at IAM Level I and II. It applies to those responsible for assessing risk and establishing security requirements using the RMF model. Prerequisite: 1-2 years' IT security, risk management, systems, and network experience.
